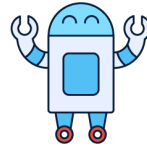

Here are a few things you need to know about camp this year!

- Camp Stratiotes is for any child entering the 4th grade thru those who have completed the 12th grade.
- This year, camp registration will be done exclusively online. To register, visit www.wkyc.org/date_rate. **DO NOT pay through WKYC's website!** Instead make check payable to Mt. Juliet Church of Christ for the amount due on or before June 2nd.
- The deadline to register for camp is May 19th. Space is limited and reservations will be made on a first- come, first-serve basis!
- Campers and parents need to be at the Mt. Juliet church of Christ on June 2nd at 12:00pm to complete the check-in and registration process. We want to make sure we have everything that we need (medications, forms, payment, etc.) before we

leave on the charter buses for Kentucky.

- Finally, we want to invite you to join us for Family Night on Thursday evening at camp. After supper Thursday, we will have a devotional and night time activity. If you would like to take your child home with you Thursday night (or if they will be riding home with someone else that night), **YOU MUST** let the camp director know.
- We will return Friday, June 7th to the Mt. Juliet church of Christ around 12:30pm.
